Prior to July 1968 the University at Buffalo utilized a three (3) point grade system, as noted below. All grade point averages have been recalculated utilizing our current four (4) point grade system.

Each semester hour of

A (High Distinction)	= 3 quality points
B (Superior)	= 2
C (Average)	= 1
D (Minimum Passing Grade)	= 0
F (Failure)	= -1
